Student Travel Grants

Through the generosity of one of our sponsors, Ktech Corporation, the Megagauss 2006 Conference is fortunate to be able to offer small travel grants to a very limited number of students who would not otherwise be able to attend the Conference in Santa Fe.

The grants, up to \$500, are intended to make it possible for students who may be working in, or considering work in, one of the technical areas addressed by the Conference to have the opportunity to attend, meet the community, and engage in dialogue with other attendees.

Application for the grants should be in the form of a letter from the student, outlining their area(s) of interest and current engagement with the technology of ultra-high magnetic fields or science conducted in high fields. A brief sentence or two of endorsement from their academic supervisor should be appended to the letter. Applications by e-mail are acceptable and should be provided by October 15.

Recipients will be expected to register for the Conference at the "student" rate, provide receipts for their travel, lodging, and incidental expenses (up to the maximum of the grant) and a brief report, in letter format, describing their experience at the Conference.

While we will be able to provide this support to only a small number of students, we are nonetheless appreciative of the assistance of our sponsor that makes it possible to engage the next generation of researchers in the field.

TRANSPORTATION

Santa Fe is most conveniently reached by air through the Albuquerque International Sunport, served by many major airlines.

The Lodge is an easy, 1-1/2 hour drive by rental car (all major companies) or shuttle from the Sunport to the Lodge. Shuttle transportation can be arranged through [Sandia Shuttle Express](#).

By car, the Lodge is on Bishop's Lodge Road, about three miles north of historic downtown Santa Fe Plaza.
